I Left My Luggage

Traditional rhyme adapted by Lucinda Geoghegan

000 000 NYCOS

I left my lug-gage on the left hand side of the shelf on the left in the left lug-gage office near by (tap right knee, tap left knee) It was right on the edge, right on the edge right on the edge, just left right there on the left hand side of the shelf on the left in the Left lug-gage office nearby

This is a knee tapping game with a bit of a catch in the middle. At the beginning, you should keep a steady beat by tapping the left knee then the right, beginning on the left knee on the word **left**. However, half-way through the song, you should change to the rhythm of the words to make sure that you are tapping the correct knee. Keep going with the beat at **left right there** where the correct knee should be tapped according to the words.

It's a challenge, but you will get there with practice!

ANOTHER CHALLENGE

Try marching to the rhyme above and make sure you end up with left leg/right leg at the correct time. Remember when watching the video it will be in mirror image.

Try saying the whole rhyme in your head but marching as before.
